NO MORE BUMPS WITH FLOW-RITE REMOTE DRAIN PLUG

When loading the trailer after a day boating, it's important to open the drain plug to clear out any residual water. Because it's located at the lowest point of the hull, it's easy to bump a head or get splashed while doing so. The innovative Remote Drain Plug from Flow-Rite makes these scenarios a thing of the past. Its control knob operates from inside the boat and shows whether the plug is in or out.

Built in the USA, the Flow-Rite Remote Drain Plug consists of the plug, plus a 6', 8' or 10' cable and control knob actuator. It's made of a durable polymer that won't rust or cause galvanic corrosion. Because it's one piece, the plug can't be misplaced or lost in between concrete ramp slabs. Plus, draining the hull is an easy way to help control the spread of invasive aquatic species. A video is at bit.ly/RemoteDrainPlug

The Flow-Rite Remote Drain Plug is easy to install with household tools on most fiberglass or aluminum hulls. It requires a common 1" mounting hole on the transom and 1-3/4" for the actuator. Two popular locations for the control are next to the throttle and in the engine splashwell. Prices start at \$89.95.
